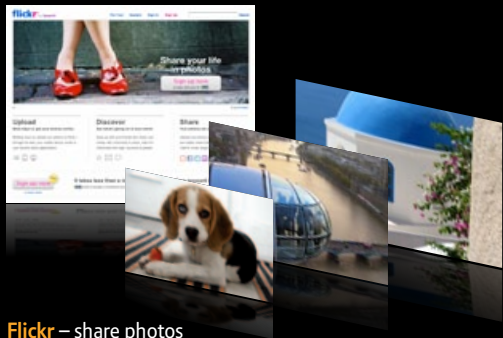

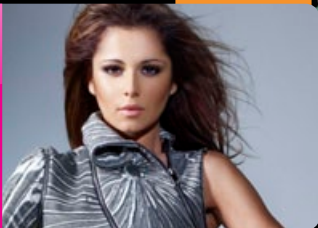

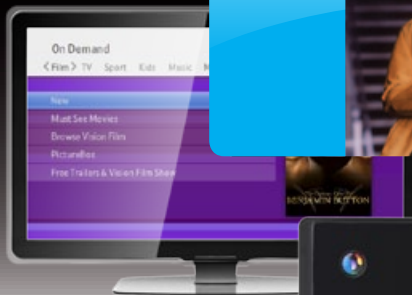

Problems connecting?


If you can't get online, try:

1 Restarting

Before trying anything else, restart your computer and your Hub. This fixes most connection problems.

To restart your Hub, press and release the **Restart** button on the back of your Hub. Wait for the Power and Broadband lights to turn blue.

2 Running desktop help (PCs only)

If restarting didn't work, run free BT Broadband Desktop Help – just double-click  on your desktop. If it isn't on your desktop, download BT Broadband Desktop Help at www.bt.com/help/broadbanddesktophelp

BT Broadband Desktop Help will:

- alert you if you have a problem
- support you 24 hours a day
- help you get back online
- set up or troubleshoot your email account
- run a PC health check
- fix problems in the background
- help you set up your home network
